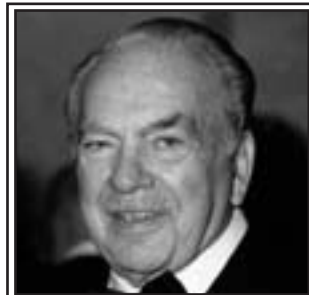

**PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**

**Notice to Owners/Residents of 77 properties in Thornton affected by watermain installation projects on Barrie Street between Meadowland Boulevard and Thornton Avenue, Robert Street between Barrie Street and the Thornton Fire Hall and Henry Street between Robert Street and 4 Henry Street.**

In 2003, 2004 and 2005, watermain installations and associated works were completed at the above noted locations for a total cost of \$570,960.92, less a Developer's contribution of \$178,000.00 towards same leaving \$392,960.92 to be financed. In addition, \$1,009,227.54 was spent on the Glen Avenue pumphouse expansion, plus \$12,123.13 to decommission the Camilla Pumphouse. After Development Charges plus OSTAR funding have been applied, the non-growth cost of capacity for the affected 77 properties with respect to the expansion/upgrades to the pumphouse is \$56,137,24.

The proposed special capital charge for municipal water is \$6,613.00 per connection, plus \$500.00 for each unit within a commercial or residential multi-complex serviced by such connection. Municipal water projects benefit only those properties abutting the works and as such are considered local service charges, and not to be included in the Township's overall budget.

**Notice to Septage, Portable Toilet and Holding Tank Waste Haulers/ Disposal Operators and Residents**

The Angus Waste Water Treatment Plant Expansion project is scheduled to be completed by the end of July, 2006. This facility can accommodate 11.2 cubic metres of septage, portable toilet and holding tank waste on a daily basis. Priority shall be given for disposal of such wastes generated from properties within the municipality. The following waste water disposal fees are proposed:

- \$75.00 per thousand gallons or less, or \$16.50 per cubic metre
- \$ 50.00 per address Administration Fee for wastes originating from outside boundaries of the Township of Essa.

To ensure payment, a deposit may be required in advance of disposal of wastes.

Before Council passes a By-law to impose the special capital charge for connection to the municipal water system in Thornton, plus the waste water disposal fee at the Angus Waste Water Treatment Plant, a **Public Meeting is being held at the Essa Administration Centre, at 5786 County Road 21, on July 5, 2006, starting at 6:30 p.m.** to allow those owners/residents affected by these charges/fees to make representation with respect to this matter.
