Fatality on County Rd. 27

South Simcoe Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision which occurred on County Road # 27, south of Cookstown on Wednesday evening at approximately 10:30pm.

Police report that a 1991 Nissan was being operated northbound on County Road # 27 south of Line # 14 when it lost control, crossed the centre line and was struck head-on by a southbound Isuzu Rodeo.

The driver of the Nissan, a 32 year old Alliston man was pronounced dead at the scene by paramedics.

life-threatening injuries.

Innisfil woman charged with Possession of Cocaine

On Monday December 11, 2006 at 3:24pm the accused was observed travelling at a high rate of speed northbound on 25 Sideroad, Town of Innisfil, County of Simcoe. A South Simcoe officer activated emergency equipment as the accused turned northbound on Lockhart Rd and she was observed leaning to the passenger

side several times and appeared to be hiding something and was slow to stop. The accused readily admitted to a troubled past including consuming acid, marijuana and every other drug but not anymore. The officer looked down and observed in her open purse on top of the passenger seat 2 bags containing a white residue. The

officer cautioned her at this point and then requested if she had anything else in the vehicle to which she produced a small bag containing crack cocaine out of her left sleeve.

The accused was arrested and released on a form 9 appearance notice. The cocaine was seized and returned to the station.

Update on Serious Personal Injury Collision

South Simcoe Police have completed their investigation into a serious motor vehicle collision involving two motorcycles which occurred on Artesian Industrial Parkway in Bradford on August 31st at approximately 12:30pm.

Police report that three motorcycles were travelling northbound on Artesian Industrial Parkway when the rear motorcycle pulled out and attempted to pass the other two motorcycles.

During the pass, two of the motorcycles collided throwing both operators from their motorcycles on to the roadway.

The driver of the motorcycle that was passing, a 36-year old Midland man was airlifted to Saint Michael's Hospital in Toronto with serious injuries. The operator of the

motorcycle being overtaken, a 51-year old Midland man was transported to South Lake Hospital in Newmarket with non-life threatening injuries. The third motorcycle was not directly involved in the collision.

The driver of the passing motorcycle has now been charged under the Highway Traffic Act with Careless Driving. He is scheduled to appear in Bradford Court on January 15th, 2007 to answer to the charges. If convicted, he faces a maximum fine of \$1000 and a two year drivers licence suspension.

Police report that the driver has been hospitalized since the collision, which prevented them from laying charges sooner.

Missing youth from Alliston - public assistance required

Nottawasaga OPP are requesting the assistance of the public in locating a 16 year old male from his residence in Alliston.

On Monday, December 11th, Derrick Spencer, born April 29, 1990, went missing from his family residence. The occurrence is out of the norm for the youth. His whereabouts and possible destination are unknown and Nottawasaga OPP

are requesting the assistance in locating this missing person.

Mr. Spencer is described as; Male, white, 5'10" tall, between 140-150 lbs., with short brown hair, gapped teeth.

Domestic Assault

On Tuesday December 5, at approximately 6:15 p.m police received a call of a domestic dispute at a residence in Cookstown. Upon arrival, officers spoke to a female who indicated she had returned home late from a trip to Niagara Falls and was met by her common-law husband who was mad because she was not at home cooking his dinner. During this argument, he grabbed her by

the shirt, shook her and yelled at her. As a result, a 69 year old male from Cookstown and Niagara Falls was arrested and charged with domestic assault. He was held for a bail hearing on December 6th in Barrie.

Fail to Comply With Conditions

On Tuesday December 5, at approximately 7:50 a.m. police were called to an Alcona address in the Town of Innisfil to investigate a

911 hang up call. Upon arrival, officers spoke to a male and female who had been involved in a verbal argument. While investigating the incident, officers became aware that the male was in breach of previous bail conditions by being at the female's residence and staying with her. Officers were informed that the male had been arrested and charged with assaulting the female in Peel Region earlier in the year, and was not to have any association or communication with her. As a result, a 34 year old male of no fixed address was arrested and charged with

Failing to Comply With Conditions. He was held for a bail hearing later the same day.

Unlawfully In A Dwelling

On December 7, South Simcoe Police were contacted by a Bradford resident. The complainant who was away from the residence at the time had received information that a male party known to the family may have attended the residence without the homeowners permission. Police subsequently attended the residence and searched the premises. Police located a male party hiding in a bedroom closet.

Crime of the Week - Barrie liquor store robbery

Suspicious male taking photos of children

Essa Twp, — On Monday, Nottawasaga OPP officers were dispatched to patrol Angus and surrounding area for a suspicious motor vehicle that was parked on Sydenham St. in Angus, at 2 p.m., containing a male driver reportedly taking photos with a camera of children on a school property.

The only description of the suspect vehicle was that of a four door silver car and the only descriptors available of the suspect were male, black hair and black jacket. The suspect vehicle was not found at initial reported location and no direction of travel from the scene was available.

The area was thoroughly patrolled by officers to locate the vehicle but results at that time were negative.

The OPP requests that incidents of this nature be reported promptly with as much detail as possible to police in the interest of safety for all school age children.

The investigation is continuing.
