Notice to Town of Innisfil Property Owners

Please watch the mail for your 2007 Final Property Tax Bill for the Residential, Farm, Managed Forest or Pipeline classes. This bill is due in two approximately equal installments on:

Friday, June 29, 2007 and
Friday, September 28, 2007

NOTE: Over the next few weeks traffic flow in and out of the Town Administration Centre driveways may be affected by construction works in the vicinity. For your convenience, you may wish to make your payments online, or by mailing in your cheque to the Town Administration Centre. Should your installment payment be received by the Town subsequent to these due dates, you will be liable for late payment penalty at the rate of 1.25% of the installment amount that was not paid on time.

If you have not received your Property Tax Bill, please contact Financial Services as soon as possible. If there are any changes to your mailing address, the Municipal Act requires these changes to be submitted in writing. A change of address form, complete with instructions is available on the Town's website, www.innisfil.ca. Failure to receive a Property Tax Bill does not relieve the owner's responsibility of payments due nor liability for penalty and interest charged.

The Final Property Tax Bills for the Commercial, Industrial and Multi-Residential property tax classes will be issued after the County-wide capping calculations have been completed in accordance with Provincial Legislation.
